Parties and responsibilities for the treatment of yours data

Grövelsjöfjällen Turistförening Ideell Förening org.no. 884401-3345, adress Älvgatan 71, 792 32 Mora (hereafter referred to as the Association) is responsible for personal data the processing of personal data that takes place within the framework of the association activity.

The association aims to promote and develop tourism in Grövelsjöfjällen.

Why do we process your personal data?

In order for the association to be able to conduct its business, personal data is processed for various purposes linked to the business.

The association processes personal data to administer on an ongoing basis association activities, such as information to members, invitations to membership meetings as well as manage member-related financial transactions such as membership fees.

The association also processes personal data to apply for grants at specific development. Ex. The Swedish Agency for Economic and Regional Growth, Swedish Board of Agriculture and the association's home municipality.

The association is responsible for the personal data in the process of personal data when:

- * Managing membership in the association
- * Administration of the association
- * Applying for grants
- * Contacting member
- * Visit to our website
- * Publishing material on website and social media

Who do we share personal information with?

The data will not be transferred to third parties and your personal data will not be subjected to automated decision making.

What legal basis do we have for the processing of personal data?

The association has below compiled the legal basis for the treatment of personal data that occurs within the association's activities.

How long do we store your personal data?

The association will carry out an annual assessment of the purpose of processing of personal data remains. If not the treatment of personal data remains, the data will be deleted.

What rights do you have?

You, as a member of the association have several rights that you should know about.

You have the right to receive a register extract regarding the association's treatment of your personal data. At the request of register extracts, the association will provide you with one a copy of the personal data being processed. For any further Copies that you request may the association charge a reasonable fee based on administrative cost.

You have the right to have your personal data corrected if they are incorrect, incomplete or misleading and the right to limit the processing of personal data until they will be changed.

You have the right to be deleted under certain circumstances:

- * If the data is no longer needed for the purposes for which it was collected.
- * If the treatment is based on the individual's consent and you withdraw consent.
- * If the treatment is for direct marketing and you oppose this.
- * If you oppose personal data processing within the framework of "exercise of authority" or after a balance of interest, and there is no legitimate reasons that outweigh your interests.
- * If the personal data has been processed illegally
- * If deletion is required to fulfil a legal obligation
- * If the personal data refers to children and has been collected in connection with the child creates a profile in a social network.

You also have the right to withdraw consent, automatically oppose decision-making, profiling and objecting to direct marketing.

You can exercise your rights at any time by requesting access to and rectification or deletion of personal data, request limitation of processing or object to treatment. Contact the Board to exercise your rights, visit www.grovelsjon.com/
